Dear Kfeirians:

Your Board of Trustees for the year 1951 is very happy to report to you that we have made considerable progress in our endeavor to install in the Kfeir the electric power plant which we undertook a few years ago. True, it has been a long and tedious job, but trying to handle an installation of this kind, half way around the world, imposes many problems which are caused by the world situation today.

In November, 1950 we sent to the firm of Aziz Tu'meh Rahal & Co. the sum of \$4,844.00 in payment for the generators to be installed in the building which was constructed in the Kfeir, which we told you about at our meeting in Huntington in September, 1950. Considerable correspondence went on between us and the engineers, and on July 6, 1951 we were asked to send an additional \$1,000.00 which was to cover the increased cost of material, brought about by the world situation today. On July 31, 1951 we received a letter from the engineers stating that they were installing several 200 watt lamps on the roof of the building to light the Village. We are sure that we were all there in spirit on this memorable occasion. The engineers also informed us that they were successful in obtaining from the Lebanese Government a franchise dated July 21, 1951, giving the people in the Village of Kfeir the right to utilize electric power and light from the generators installed. The next problem is that of having poles and wire strung in the Village, in order that residents of the Village may utilize the facilities which we have furnished them. This we are now undertaking, with the aid of engineers and the Kfeirian Society in Kfeir.

We hope that by next year at this time everyone in Kfeir will have electricity installed in their homes to lighten their burden.

We have for you a map of the Kfeir, which we are offering at a nominal cost. This map has been reduced in size from an original we received from the engineers in Kfeir, showing each and every house and street in the Village and indicating thereon who the owners are. This may be purchased at the Registration Desk all during the Convention.
