

The Next Generation of Kfeirians

For the past 40 years, we have supported our next generation Kfeirians by offering scholarships to aid in their college education. Our scholarship program was launched in 1964 and since then, we have awarded over 125 scholarships. The scholarship program has become a tradition of this Reunion that characterizes the nature of Kfeirians — a warm, giving, pioneering people.

Over the years, the cost of a college education has continued to rise, but our scholarship program has struggled to keep pace. We have continued to award scholarships based on the funds available but donations have decreased. Of the 1,200 families in our Reunion, less than 1 percent made a contribution last year.

When you contribute to the scholarship program, you are not just making a donation. Yes, that is certainly part of it, but more importantly, you are planting a seed in the lives of our Kfeirian youth. The future of the Reunion is dependant upon our Kfeirian youth and we are dependant upon you to support them. When you help support their education, it's as if you are telling them... "your forefathers came to this country with empty pockets, but hearts filled with courage. You are the fulfillment of their dream — to have

opportunities they never had in this great country of America. We support you and send you forth to get an education. Now go. Make a difference in your schools, in your community, in this Reunion. Make a difference in all that you place your hands to!"

The forefathers of this Reunion were men and women of faith and followed a Biblical principle found in the book of Proverbs (13:22) which is "a good man leaves an inheritance for his children's children".

Many people who founded the Reunion are no longer with us, but they sacrificed so that it could be left as an inheritance to us. It is now our responsibility to ensure that the inheritance they left us in this Reunion continues to be left as an inheritance for our children's children.
