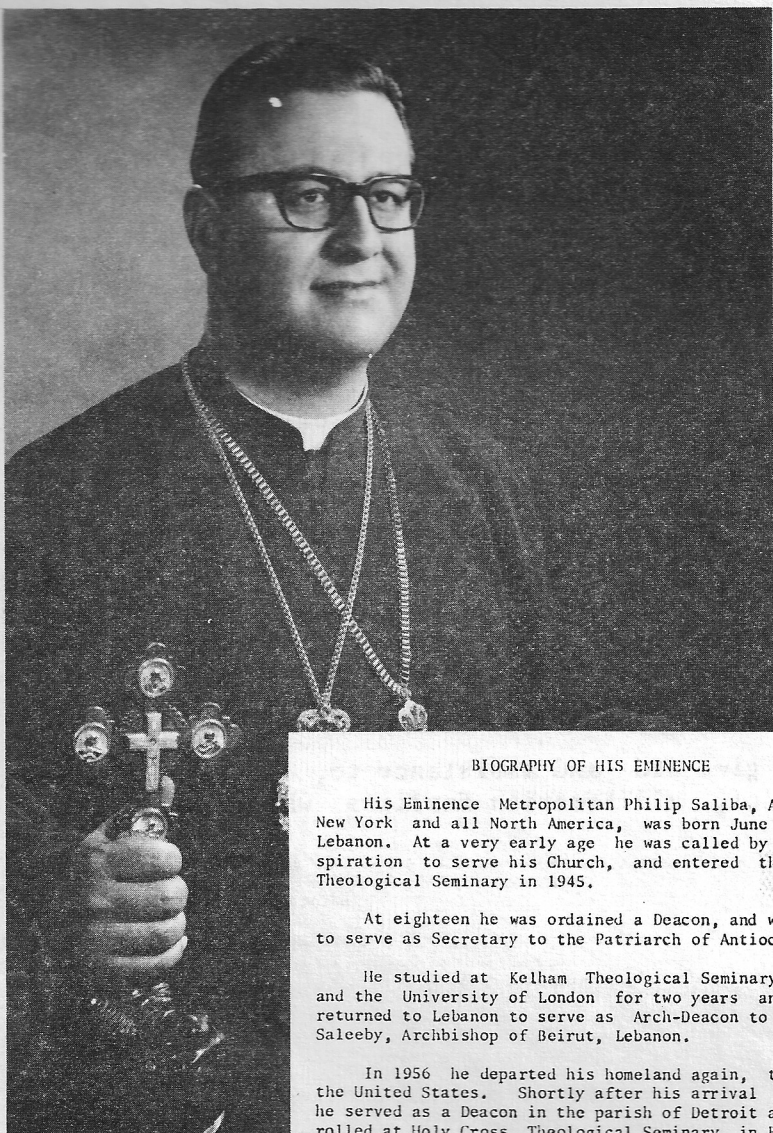
AIM AND PURPOSE
OF
KFEIRIAN REUNION FOUNDATION

TO provide a suitable method of association and reunion for all members of Kfeirian families in the North American Continent;

TO instill in them a love for our democratic way of life, with its freedom of opportunity, freedom of worship and justice under law;

TO promote and foster education, religion, and scientific research among Kfeirians; and

TO give aid and assistance to, and attend the welfare of, all Kfeirian families wherever they may be.



BIOGRAPHY OF HIS EMINENCE

His Eminence Metropolitan Philip Saliba, Archbishop of New York and all North America, was born June 10, 1931 in Lebanon. At a very early age he was called by a Divine inspiration to serve his Church, and entered the Balamand Theological Seminary in 1945.

At eighteen he was ordained a Deacon, and was appointed to serve as Secretary to the Patriarch of Antioch.

He studied at Kelham Theological Seminary in England, and the University of London for two years and in 1955 he returned to Lebanon to serve as Arch-Deacon to Metropolitan Saleeby, Archbishop of Beirut, Lebanon.

In 1956 he departed his homeland again, this time for the United States. Shortly after his arrival in the U. S. he served as a Deacon in the parish of Detroit and then enrolled at Holy Cross Theological Seminary in Boston. From Holy Cross he went on to Wayne State University in Detroit, where he received his B. A. Degree. In 1959 Deacon Philip Saliba was ordained into the Priesthood by the Late Metropolitan Anthony Bashir, in Cleveland, where he remained for seven years.

In February 1966 Metropolitan Anthony Bashir, Archbishop of the Syrian Antiochian Orthodox Archdiocese of New York and all North America, passed from this life. On August 14, 1966, Archmandrite Philip Saliba was consecrated Metropolitan Philip, Archbishop of the Syrian Antiochian Orthodox Archdiocese of New York and All North America. At 35, he was one of the youngest to ever hold this position.

Archbishop Philip, is an American citizen, and has taken an active part in championing the cause of right in many areas.

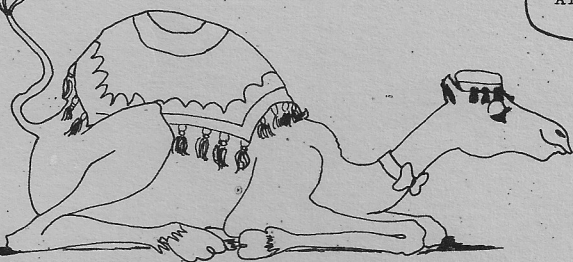
