#### **KFEIR 2000!**

The Kfeirian Reunion Board of Directors announce a Kfeirian Reunion sponsored trip to the Kfeir in July of 2000. (This will NOT replace the regularly scheduled Reunion at Labor Day that year, but will just be an additional trip offered to Kfeirians.) It will consist of two days and two nights in the Kfeir with food, activities, dancing, music, hotel, and transportation included. Since there is no hotel in the Kfeir, hotel accommodations will be arranged in nearby Zahle where breakfast will be served prior to the bus taking us to the Kfeir for the day.

Fair market prices indicate that this two day, two night event with food and hotel and entertainment all inclusive for \$350. We will arrive in Zahle on the 14th of July and visit the Kfeir all day on the 15th and 16th. We have a full schedule of activities for your enjoyment.

We have worked with several tour companies, and are now able to inform you of a 15 day tour to Lebanon and Syria which will include the Kfeir weekend. Sharon Jones of Travel Network has put together a very wonderful itinerary and includes experienced, professional travel guides with 5 star hotels, many lunches and dinners, and all the sights. The total cost of the trip depends on the number of travelers,

10 - 19 = \$2775 20 - 29 = \$2725 30 - 39 = \$2645 40 & up = \$2575

The tour includes travel from New York to Beirut, Byblos, Tyre, Baalbek, Jounieh, and other historic features of Lebanon, as well as a tour of Damascus, Sednaya, Maaloula, and Bosra. The trip is complete and we are now taking deposits of \$100 to save your spot. Space will be limited, and inclusion in this historic event is on a first come, first serve basis. In addition, the tour company will make special arrangements if you cannot make the full two weeks and want to attend the two nights and days in the Kfeir.
