### Kfeirian Reunion History and Trivia to Be Proud Of!

The first Kfeirian Reunion was in 1932 in Huntington, W.Va., and was called the Kfeirian Brotherhood.

The Kfeirian Reunion Foundation was established in 1948 and incorporated in the state of Ohio; the Foundation became a 501-C non-profit organization on September 26, 1995.

The Kfeirian Reunion Scholarship Program for Kfeirian ancestors has provided over 130 scholarships since its inception in 1964, totaling approximately \$312,000.

The Kfeirian Reunion Foundation seal was introduced in 1968.

In 1982, at the 50th Reunion, Kevin Donley created the Kfeirian Family Tree which now has more than 4,100 names, 1,126 marriages and 723 surnames and represents 17 generations. Check out the Tree at www.kfeir.com and be sure to give Kevin any updates!

While the Kfeirian Reunion has predominately been held in West Virginia and Ohio where our immigrants originally settled, new and exciting locations have also included Orlando, Fla., Las Vegas, Nev., Miami, Fla., and Los Angeles, Ca.

Over the last 75 years, the Kfeirian Reunion Foundation has contributed to the village of Kfeir to improve the irrigation system, assist in paving the main thoroughfare road and install a new generator.



DoubleDay's best seller list for 24 years as an international classic. When it went out of print there was a continuous demand for the book, Corey saw the need to revise the book and gave it a new title, *Healthy Syrian and Lebanese Cooking*. Many new photos and additional recipes are included in this revised edition, plus health benefits of the foods and useful Arabic phrases used every day. Corey also

produced a cooking video show (70 minute running time) titled, *The Art of Syrian & Lebanese Cooking*, a companion to the cookbook. Her appearances throughout the country have dubbed her book as a "cultural treasure".
