





Al Kfeir, Lebanon

The beautiful village of Kfeir is located 70 miles southeast of Beirut, Lebanon and 70 miles southwest of Damascus, Syria. It lies at the foot of snow capped Mt. Haramon, which is mentioned many times in the Bible. The economy consists mainly of agriculture. The main products are olives and pistachio nuts. Approximately 800 families of Kfeirian descent now reside in North America.

PROUD HERITAGE

From the day of our first meeting in 1932, Kfeirians have looked out for each other. We have come to recognize that times change but Kfeirians don't. This fact alone is one of our greatest attributes. Over the past 37 years, many changes have come about in our country. One thing stands out over all — the strength and stability of the Kfeirians in our country.

Today's society is one of protest and rebellion. We have seen more chaos and violence on our streets in the past 5 years than most countries experience in a war. It is during times like this that we can truly understand the position and effects of our Kfeirian heritage. I maintain that in the young people's wandering and searching lies the answer to many of our questions that we continually ask. They are searching for guidance. They are seeking direction. They say they want independence, but they can't live with the responsibilities that go with it. Let me quickly add that many of these young people do not have the ties to link them to the past. They do not feel the family ties that will give security and guidance to young people in their search for the rewards of life. What a lesson many people in this world could take from the Kfeirians. The position of the family and church among Kfeirians is uppermost in their daily lives. We feel the love and compassion for all our cousins wherever they may be.

Our love and compassion has been shown over the years by our desire to improve the conditions that exist for our families in Kfeir. To mention just a few, we must include the refurnishing of the church in Kfeir and the continual help to those in need. Our work in this country is encouraged by our dedicated Board of Directors who guide and lead toward specific goals of dedication and understanding among all our families. Our scholarship committee is firmly established to help young Kfeirians in their search for knowledge through higher education. At the present time, we are assisting four young people to defray college costs. In the past five years, we have seen two of our recipients graduate from college, one of whom received money from the Foundation during all four years of college.

At no time during this exposition have I mentioned any famous names of our known cousins. I strongly believe that all Kfeirians are famous because of what they believe in and what they stand for. We can speak proudly of our heritage. We can look at our accomplishments with pride and recognize that we have done our part in making this the strongest and greatest nation in the world.
